



COVID-19 Safety Precautions

All guidelines/precautions have been created in accordance to the guidelines set forth by the State of NH and the CDC.

Pre-Check:

- Students should not attend class if they reply “yes” to any of the following:
 - Any symptoms of COVID-19 or fever of 100.4 degrees F or higher
 - Close contact with someone who is suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19 in the past 14 days
 - Traveled in the past 14 days (internationally, by cruise ship or outside of NH, VT, or ME on public transportation)
- Students should come dressed and ready for class (including their dance shoes on). They may bring in a small dance bag if they change shoes while in class. Extra belongings should be very limited and on a “need basis” only.
- Staff must pass a health screening each day

Check-in/out Procedures:

- Students will be met/dismissed by an instructor at the front door (Students should follow markings to maintain appropriate social distancing while waiting to enter)
- All students must sanitize their hands upon entering/exiting
- Students will be directed to a socially distanced (clearly marked) spot to participate in class

Precautions:

- Enhanced frequency and strength of cleaning schedule is in place
- Staff may wear masks depending on appropriateness of situation
- Students will be directed to socially distanced (clearly marked) spots to participate in class

- All classes have been restructured to assume social distancing. We have also eliminated the use of most props (with the exception of props that can be thoroughly disinfected in between each use)
- Older students may take a portion of their class outside, at the instructor's discretion
- Staggered Class times to minimize the amount of individuals in Happy Feet at one time, while maintaining the most efficient traffic flow possible.
- The lobby will be temporarily closed. Should parents of younger students need to enter the facility, they will be required to wear a mask and will be limited to 1 adult per student in the lobby.
 - We're sad to say that at this time, there will be no chairs in our lobby.
 - Parents are welcome to walk around to the back of the building. Both studios have windows along that side of the building. Parents are welcome to observe class from there.
- Staff will have to refrain from hugs and high five's at this time
- Hand sanitizer is made available throughout the facility
- Happy Feet will follow the guidance provided from the State's Health Department should a case be reported at Happy Feet.
